## 36.01.02.07 Handicapped Children

General Fund Appropriation, provided that appropriated for nonpublic placements and returnees to Maryland categories may be used to develop a broad range of services to assist in returning children with special needs out-of-state placements to Maryland; to prevent new out-of-state placements of children with special needs; to prevent unnecessary residential or institutional placements within Maryland; and to work with local jurisdictions in these regards.
