

Amendment No. 6:

On page 36, in line 20, strike the word “legislation” and substitute “Senate Bill 100 or House Bill 150”.

Amendment No. 7:

On page 37, in line 12, strike the word “legislation” and substitute “Senate Bill 100 or House Bill 150”.

Amendment No. 8:

On page 39, in line 15, strike the word “legislation” and substitute “Senate Bill 100 or House Bill 150”.

Amendment No. 9:

On page 40, in line 22, strike the word “Administration” and substitute “Unit”.

Amendment No. 10:
