JURY SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE PRESIDING JUDGE WITHOUT DESIGNATION OF VENUE.

- (2) THE PRESIDING JUDGE SHALL DESIGNATE THE PLACE OF VENUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRIAL.
- (3) THE PRESIDING JUDGE MAY DIRECT THE CONSOLIDATION OF AN INDICTMENT RETURNED BY A GRAND JURY WITH AN INDICTMENT RETURNED BY A STATE GRAND JURY AND FIX VENUE FOR TRIAL.
- (M) THE COSTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO A STATE GRAND JURY SHALL BE PAID FROM FUNDS APPROPRIATED IN THE BUDGET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 413

(House Bill 492)

AN ACT concerning

Drunk and Drugged Driving
