

DETERMINE ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION TAKEN THAT INDICATED AN ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION OF 0.10 OR MORE AT THE TIME OF TESTING, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THESE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFENSES COMMITTED AT THE SAME TIME, OR ARISING OUT OF CIRCUMSTANCES SIMULTANEOUS IN TIME AND PLACE, OR ARISING OUT OF THE SAME INCIDENT, THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) SHALL SUSPEND THE DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFENSE THAT RESULTS IN THE LENGTHIEST PERIOD OF SUSPENSION; AND

(2) MAY NOT IMPOSE ANY ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF SUSPENSION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFENSES.

(H) (H) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, A TEST FOR DRUG OR CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE CONTENT UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) MAY NOT BE REQUESTED; AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, REQUIRED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, OR DIRECTED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, BY A POLICE OFFICER UNLESS THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF WHICH THE OFFICER IS A MEMBER HAS THE CAPACITY TO HAVE SUCH TESTS CONDUCTED; AND

(2) A TEST FOR DRUG OR CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE CONTENT OF A PERSON'S BLOOD UNDER THIS SECTION MAY ONLY BE REQUESTED, AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, REQUIRED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, OR DIRECTED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, BY A POLICE OFFICER WHO IS DESIGNATED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE AS A PARTICIPANT OR TRAINEE IN A PROGRAM OF TRAINING OF POLICE OFFICERS AS DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERTS CONDUCTED BY THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE FEDERAL NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION.

(2) MAY ONLY BE REQUESTED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, REQUIRED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, OR DIRECTED AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, BY A POLICE OFFICER WHO IS A TRAINEE, HAS BEEN TRAINED, OR IS PARTICIPATING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY IN A PROGRAM OF TRAINING THAT IS:

(I) DESIGNED TO TRAIN AND CERTIFY POLICE OFFICERS AS DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERTS; AND

(II) CONDUCTED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF THE STATE, OR ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPAL, OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT
