CHAPTER 415

(House Bill 544)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services – Correctional Facilities – Construction – Procurement Authority

FOR the purpose of establishing the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services as a primary procurement unit for construction and construction related services, supplies, materials, and equipment, ~~and architectural and engineering services~~ related to State correctional facilities; providing for the transfer of certain rights, duties, and funds; transferring certain duties concerning architectural and engineering services for State correctional facilities from the Department of General Services to the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services; requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to apply certain price preferences under certain conditions; authorizing the General Selection Board to waive certain requirements under certain conditions; declaring the intent of the General Assembly; requiring the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services to submit a certain report by a certain date; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to procurement authority for State correctional facilities.
