SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Finance and Procurement

4-406.

- (G) (1) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), (E), AND (F) OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES AS DEFINED IN § 11–101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 41, § 4–104.1 OF THE CODE, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), (E), AND (F) OF THIS SECTION FOR STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

  - (k) "Primary procurement units" means:
    - (1) the State Treasurer;
    - (2) the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning;
    - (3) the Department of General Services;
    - (4) the Department of Transportation;
    - (5) the University of Maryland System; [and]
    - (6) the Maryland Port Commission; AND
- (7) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.
- (U) (1) "STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES" MEANS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS, AND ALL PLACES OF CORRECTIONAL CONFINEMENT, THAT ARE LOCATED WITHIN THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND ARE PRIMARILY OPERATED BY THE MARYLAND STATE GOVERNMENT.

    - (i) insurance;
