

CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

(D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL INSPECT AND APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE ANY MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND METHODS USED IN CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY AND SHALL MAKE INSPECTIONS OF THE FACILITY DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION.

(2) THE DUTY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT RELIEVE AN ARCHITECT OR ENGINEER OF ANY SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY FOR WHICH THE ARCHITECT OR ENGINEER IS EMPLOYED.

(E) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH IN § 11-101(U) OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 4-310 THROUGH 4-315 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE:

(1) THE PURCHASE OF ALL SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT IN SUPPORT OF CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;

(2) AN INVOICE FOR SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY MAY NOT BE PAID UNTIL THE INVOICE HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES OR A DESIGNEE OF THE SECRETARY; AND

(3) CONSISTENT WITH DIVISION II OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL SET STANDARDS FOR SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

(4) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH IN § 11-101(U) OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
