- 1. EXISTING LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE, OR STATE INSTITUTIONAL STAFF AND AN OUTSIDE EXPERT OR EXPERTS; OR
 - 2. OUTSIDE EXPERTS.
 - (2) THE PANEL SHALL:
- (I) COLLECT AND ANALYZE DATA AND INFORMATION CONCERNING THE SUBJECT ASSIGNED TO IT FOR REVIEW;
- (II) CONDUCT AN EVALUATION OF THE STATUTE OR LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL ASSIGNED TO IT FOR REVIEW, INCLUDING THE SOCIAL AND FISCAL COSTS AND BENEFITS; AND
 - (III) BASED ON DATA SUBMITTED:
- 1. REPORT ON WHETHER SUFFICIENT DATA EXISTS TO MAKE AN EVALUATION;
- 2. RECOMMEND THE REPORTING AND COLLECTION OF STATISTICS AND DATA NEEDED TO EVALUATE THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OR, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, AND BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISIONS;
- 3. RECOMMEND CHANGES ANALYZE POSSIBLE MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING OR PROPOSED MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS OR, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISIONS, AND BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISIONS;
- 4. RECOMMENDED EVALUATE THE DESIRABILITY OF A TERMINATION DATE WHERE APPROPRIATE;
- 5. REPORT ON BENEFITS AND COSTS OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OR, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, AND BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISIONS;
- 6. REPORT ON THE SCOPE AND APPLICATION OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OR, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, AND BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISIONS; AND
- 7. MAKE ANY OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS FINDINGS.
 - (3) THE PANEL MAY:
- (I) SOLICIT ADDITIONAL DATA THAT ADDRESS A PARTICULAR CRITERION; AND
- (II) HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS ON EACH SUBJECT UNDER REVIEW.
 - (4) ANY PERSON OR ORGANIZATIONS MAY SUBMIT DATA TO
