Each local coordinating council shall include at least 1 representative from:

- (1) the Mental Hygiene Administration;
- (2) the Department of Juvenile Services;
- (3) the Developmental Disabilities Administration;
- (4) THE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE ADMINISTRATION;
- [(4)] (5) the local board of education;
- [(5)] (6) the local health department; and
- [(6)] (7) the local department of social services.

Article - Family Law

15-201.

- (a) There is a Governor's Council on Adolescent Pregnancy.
- (b) The Council shall be independent, and located in the [Department of Human Resources] OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES for budgetary and administrative purposes only.

15-202.

- (a) The Council consists of the following 20 members appointed by the Governor:
 - (1) the Secretary of Human Resources;
 - (2) the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
 - (3) the Secretary of Economic and Employment Development;
 - (4) the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning;
 - (5) the State Superintendent of Schools;
- (6) the [Director] SPECIAL SECRETARY of the Office [on] FOR Children [and], Youth, AND FAMILIES;
- (7) 1 member of the Senate of Maryland nominated by the President of the Senate;
- (8) 1 member of the House of Delegates of Maryland nominated by the Speaker of the House;
- (9) 3 persons with extensive programmatic or academic experience with pregnant or parenting adolescents and their families;
 - (10) 5 persons including representatives of community, parent, or religious
