This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Section 8-117 through Section 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.

(2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under Section 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:

(ii) Provide funds for art in public spaces (Statewide), provided that this appropriation shall be used as a grant to the Citizen’s for a Maryland Monument in Gettysburg for the design, sculpting, casting, and installation of a monument at the Gettysburg National Military Park in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania to honor the memory of Maryland soldiers who fought at the Battle of Gettysburg for either the Union or the Confederacy, subject to the requirement that Citizens for a Maryland Monument in Gettysburg provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose	250,000 <u>100,000</u> <u>0</u>
