SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

{The} EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 83 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE words WORD "flag" [, "standard", "color", "ensign", or "shield" [], as used in this subtitle, shall include any flag, standard, color, ensign or shield [], or copy, picture or representation thereof, [] made of any substance or represented or produced thereon, and of any size, evidently purporting to be such flag, standard, color, ensign or shield of the United States or of this State [], or a copy, picture or representation thereof [].

No person shall publicly mutilate, deface, defile, defy, trample upon, or by word or act cast contempt upon any such flag, standard, color, ensign or shield.]

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "FLAG" MEANS THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA OR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
- (2) IN THIS SECTION, "FLAG" DOES NOT INCLUDE A COPY, PICTURE, OR REPRESENTATION OF THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
- (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE BURNING OR DESTRUCTION OF A FLAG FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSING OF A WORN FLAG.
- (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY DESTROY, BURN, OR MUTILATE A FLAG.
- A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY MUTILATE, DEFACE, DESTROY, BURN, TRAMPLE UPON, OR OTHERWISE USE A FLAG:
