

(9) (I) If the respondent is a registrant, the respondent shall pay a late filing fee of \$10 each late day, not to exceed \$250 in the aggregate, for each lobbying registration report or lobbying activity report filed after the due date.

(II) IF THE RESPONDENT HAS BEEN FOUND TO HAVE FILED A LATE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT, THE RESPONDENT SHALL PAY A LATE FEE OF \$2 FOR EACH LATE DAY NOT TO EXCEED \$250 IN THE AGGREGATE FOR EACH STATEMENT FILED AFTER THE DUE DATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 431

(Senate Bill 152)

AN ACT concerning

Radiation Control - Enforcement

FOR the purpose of ~~providing that a representative of the Department of the Environment may enter certain areas to conduct certain inspections and investigations of radiation sources;~~ providing certain procedures for the suspension, modification, or revocation of certain licenses under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department to issue certain complaints, orders, and written notices under certain circumstances; providing certain criteria for issuing any complaint, ~~order~~ order, or notice; providing for certain hearings and notice under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department subpoena powers; providing certain remedies for failure to comply with a subpoena; authorizing the Department to take certain actions to secure compliance with a certain order; authorizing the Department to bring a certain action for an injunction under certain circumstances; providing for a judicial appeal under certain circumstances; altering the maximum criminal and civil penalty for certain violations; authorizing the imposition of administrative civil penalties; ~~providing that before any action may be taken, the Department shall provide the alleged violator with a certain notice and an opportunity for a certain meeting;~~ providing certain criteria to be used in assessing administrative civil penalties under this Act; authorizing the Attorney General to take certain actions on behalf of the State in cases arising under the Maryland Radiation Act; and generally relating to enforcement of the Maryland Radiation Act.
