PERCENT DAYLIGHT FLUORESCENT ORANGE COLOR ON THE CHEST AND BACK:

- (1) (1) A person who hunts any wildlife; and
- (2) (II) A person who accompanies, aids, or assists another person IN A FIELD, WOODED AREA, MARSH, OR ON THE WATER to hunt any wildlife.
- (C) BY REGULATION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY DEFINE THE TERM "DAYLIGHT FLUORESCENT ORANGE" CONSISTENT WITH THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE NORTH AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF HUNTER SAFETY COORDINATORS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 433

(Senate Bill 158)

AN ACT concerning

Eel Pots - Licenses Eels - License Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to obtain a tidal fish license to catch eels with a pot or other device in certain waters of the State; waiving the waiting period for obtaining this license for persons who apply within a certain period of time; eliminating certain license fee exemptions; requiring certain persons catching eels to make certain reports; prohibiting persons from catching eels for sale in certain waters of the State without a license; and generally relating to the catching of eels.
