regarding the assessment of the person's property;

- (iii) identifies the comparable [residential] property by address; and
- (iv) pays the reasonable fee that the Department requires for the copy.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

(Senate Bill 219)

AN ACT concerning

Workers' Compensation - Volunteer Advanced Life Support Personnel - Coverage

- FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "public safety employee" to include certain volunteer advanced life support personnel so that those persons may be entitled to receive benefits and compensation under the workers' compensation law under certain circumstances.
