

Act requiring that the location of an underground facility be marked within 24 inches on a horizontal plane on either side of the facility shall be effective for two years from the effective date of this Act, and thereafter shall be reduced to 18 inches. If, prior to December 31, 1992, cause is shown and a final order is issued in a proceeding to be conducted by the Public Service Commission by July 1, 1992 that the 24-inch measurement should be retained then, in such event, the 24-inch measurement shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act may not be construed to require a local government to submit to a one-call system facilities plans or records that do not physically exist on the date this Act takes effect.

SECTION 2 ~~3~~, 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~July 1, 1990~~ December 31, 1990.

CHAPTER 441

(Senate Bill 244)

AN ACT concerning

Wildland and Open Areas – Calvert Cliffs Wildland

FOR the purpose of designating a certain area of land in Calvert County as the “Calvert Cliffs Wildland”; ~~excluding certain areas from the application of this Act for a certain period of time; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to study certain fields and a certain boundary and make certain recommendations by a certain date;~~ and generally relating to the designation of the Calvert Cliffs Wildland.
