

State funds. ACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED:

(1) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1991, \$735;

(2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1992, \$820; AND

(3) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1993 AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR, \$900.

(B) NO PAYMENTS FOR FUNERAL EXPENSES UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE PROVIDED BY THE LOCAL UNIT UNLESS EVERY PERSON LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE DECEDENT IS UNABLE TO PAY THE EXPENSES, AND THAT OTHER RESOURCES, INCLUDING AVAILABLE DEATH BENEFITS OF THE ESTATE OF THE DECEDENT, ARE INSUFFICIENT TO PAY THE FUNERAL EXPENSES.

(C) PAYMENTS PROVIDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL BE CHARGED TO STATE FUNDS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, ~~1990~~ 1991.

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CHAPTER 446

(Senate Bill 264)

AN ACT concerning

**Fiduciary Institutions – Confidential Financial Records – Permitted Disclosures**

FOR the purpose of expanding the list of permitted disclosures of financial records by banks, credit unions, savings and loan associations, and other fiduciary institutions to include the presentation of certain financial records to a prosecutor in a prosecution outside the State for the crime of obtaining property or services by bad check; and generally relating to permitted disclosures of confidential financial records by fiduciary institutions.
