certain course of study in order to qualify for a certain exemption from the requirements for a new tidal fish license; repealing the requirement to apply only during certain months in order to be issued a new tidal fish license; and generally relating to the requirements for a new tidal fish license to catch crabs with more than a certain number of pots or with certain bait certain fish exempting from the 2-year waiting period certain persons applying for a limited crab license; establishing a certain fee to catch certain fish; prohibiting the catching of certain fish without a certain license; altering the use of the Fisheries Research and Development Fund; specifying that the use of certain fees collected from the sale of certain licenses shall be used for certain enforcement purposes; and generally relating to tidal fish licenses.

- (a) There is a Fisheries Research and Development Fund in the Department.
