

Article 25 – County Commissioners
Section 9-I

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 – County Commissioners

9-I.

AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY, BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION, MAY FIX, IMPOSE, AND COLLECT DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES FOR FINANCING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, THE CAPITAL COSTS OF ADDITIONAL OR EXPANDED PUBLIC WORKS, IMPROVEMENTS, AND FACILITIES REQUIRED TO ACCOMMODATE NEW CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Frederick County Commissioners shall submit to the members of the General Assembly who represent any portion of Frederick County an annual written report concerning the implementation and effect of this Act. The report shall be submitted on or before commencement of each regular legislative session in ~~1991, 1992, and 1993~~ 1992, 1993, and 1994.

SECTION ~~2.~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~July 1, 1990~~ January 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 469

(Senate Bill 490)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education – University College
Maryland Higher Education Commission and University of Maryland System –
Continuing Higher Education

FOR the purpose of ~~requiring~~ authorizing the University of Maryland System to ~~maintain and enhance University College as the State's campus for continuing higher education to provide University College with funds and facilities not less than those provided to certain other public institutions of higher education in the State; requiring the Chancellor of the University of Maryland System to include in a certain plan for the University of Maryland System measures that will enhance the mission of University College as the State's campus for continuing higher education; and generally relating to University College of the University of~~
