programs in the State, analyze the impact and sources of current tuition payments, and report its findings to the Maryland Higher Education Commission, Governor, and General Assembly no later than November 1, 1990.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Higher Education Commission, in conjunction and cooperation with the Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System, the Board of Regents of Morgan State University, the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College, and the State Board for Community Colleges, shall undertake a study of the availability and appropriate method and level of funding of continuing education and other nontraditional education programs throughout the State, analyze the impact and sources of current tuition payments for such courses and programs, and report its findings to the Governor and General Assembly no later than November 1, 1990.

SECTION 2. 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

## Baltimore City - Use of Highway User Revenues

FOR the purpose of altering a financial restriction on the use of highway user revenues distributed to Baltimore City by deleting a reference to costs incurred by Baltimore City's police department authorizing for a certain time the use of highway user revenues distributed to Baltimore City to pay or finance costs incurred in providing traffic crossing guards; extending a limitation on the period of time during which highway user revenues distributed to Baltimore City are authorized to be used to pay or finance students' costs of certain public school transportation; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the use of highway user revenues in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
