SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

109.

The State Athletic Commission shall be a part of the Department of Licensing and Regulation and consist of five members. The members of the State Athletic Commission as at present constituted shall hold office for the period of their appointment. Thereafter their successors shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation for a term of six years. The Commission shall maintain general offices for the transaction of its business in the City of Baltimore. The members of the Commission shall, at their first meeting after their appointment, elect one of their number chairman of the Commission and shall adopt a seal for the
