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(e) (1) In this subsection, the term "agency" means:

(i) Any local health department;

(ii) Any local office of the State Social Services Administration;

[and]

(iii) The headquarters and any regional office of the State Motor Vehicle Administration; AND

(IV) ANY PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL, COMMUNITY COLLEGE, OR STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND

(V) ANY OTHER OFFICE OF A DEPARTMENT, ADMINISTRATION, COMMISSION, BOARD, OR OTHER ENTITY OF STATE GOVERNMENT THAT IS IDENTIFIED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS AS HAVING SIGNIFICANT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PROVIDING GOODS OR SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC AND WHOSE DAY-TO-DAY ACTIVITIES INVOLVE SIGNIFICANT CONTACT WITH THE PUBLIC IN THE OFFICE.

(2) "AGENCY" INCLUDES ANY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR OTHER PRIVATE OR QUASI PUBLIC ENTITY THAT CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE TO PERFORM OBLIGATIONS OF THE STATE.

{(2)} (3) (1) Each agency shall provide, within its offices, space and appropriate shelf, rack, or similar facilities for the display and dissemination to the public of voter registration forms and written instructions relating thereto.

(II) 1. AT THE SAME TIME AN INDIVIDUAL FILES AN APPLICATION FOR ANY BENEFITS OR SERVICES PROVIDED BY AN AGENCY, THE AGENCY SHALL OFFER THE INDIVIDUAL A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION FORM.

2. UPON COMPLETION OF THE FORM, THE INDIVIDUAL MAY RETURN THE FORM TO THE LOCAL ELECTION BOARD IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE APPLICANT RESIDES OR TO THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS FOR FORWARDING TO THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL BOARD.
