CHAPTER 477

(Senate Bill 560)

AN ACT concerning

**Vehicle Laws – Special Registration Plates – Pearl Harbor Survivors**

FOR the purpose of providing for the issuance by the Motor Vehicle Administration of certain special registration plates to members of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association; prescribing certain classes of vehicles that may be eligible to display the special registration plates; requiring an applicant for the special registration plates to provide certain information to the Administration; establishing a certain fee to be used for a certain purpose; providing for the design of the special registration plates; providing that the Administration is not required to reclaim or reissue registration plates until the regular expiration of certain plates; *making the continued applicability of this Act subject to a certain contingency*; and generally relating to the issuance and display of certain special registration plates.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Transportation**

13-618.1.

(A) (1) A MEMBER OF THE PEARL HARBOR SURVIVORS ASSOCIATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF A SPECIAL REGISTRATION NUMBER AND SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR A VEHICLE INCLUDED IN 1 OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:

(I) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;

(II) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A 3/4 TON OR LESS MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY; OR

(III) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.
