SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the 1970 Edition and January, 1987 Supplement, as amended, of Article 8 – Cecil County of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 8 - Cecil County

CHAPTER 4 ADMINISTRATOR, COUNTY

4-1. APPOINTMENT.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT A COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE.

- 4-2. CONTRACT; SALARY; RESIDENCY.
- A. ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1990, THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL RECEIVE A ONE-YEAR CONTRACT, WHICH SHALL RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
 - B. SALARY AND BENEFITS.
- (1) THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY AS ESTABLISHED IN THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S CONTRACT, BUT NOT LESS THAN THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000.) PER YEAR.
- (2) THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL DEVOTE FULL-TIME TO THE POSITION.
- (3) THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL RECEIVE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES.
 - C. IF AN INDIVIDUAL SELECTED FOR THE POSITION OF COUNTY
