(d) [(1)] Subject to the provisions of [§ 4-302 of this article, § 9-109 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, or any other provision of law] §§ 4-301 THROUGH 4-309 OF THIS ARTICLE, the records of each individual in a facility are confidential.

[(2) The lawyer representing an individual in a facility shall have access, with the written consent of the individual, to the individual's records in the course of serving the individual.

(3) An individual who is currently or was formerly treated in a facility shall have access to that individual's records in accordance with § 4-302 of this article.

(4) For purposes of this subsection, the provisions of § 4-302 of this article shall also apply to a facility.]

[(c) (1) Except as provided in § 9-109 of the Courts Article or in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a facility may not disclose any record that the facility keeps on an individual who has been admitted to the facility.

(2) On request, a facility shall disclose a record of an individual to the Director or a designee of the Director.]
