- (B) (1) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY TO AN EMPLOYER AS DEFINED IN § 29(B) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (2) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO EMPLOYERS WITH 5 OR FEWER EMPLOYEES.
- (C) EACH EMPLOYER <u>THAT HIRES EMPLOYEES TO OPERATE POWER</u> EQUIPMENT SHALL:
- (1) ASSURE THAT AN EMPLOYEE HAS RECEIVED TRAINING IN THE APPLICABLE STANDARDS FOR THE OPERATION OF POWER EQUIPMENT ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER BEFORE PERMITTING THE EMPLOYEE TO OPERATE A PARTICULAR TYPE OF POWER EQUIPMENT;
- (2) MAINTAIN WHERE PERSONNEL RECORDS ARE CUSTOMARILY KEPT A CURRENT RECORD OF THE TRAINING RECEIVED BY EACH EMPLOYEE, INCLUDING:
 - (I) DATES OF TRAINING:
 - (II) LOCATION OF TRAINING; AND
- (III) A COPY OF EACH ATTENDANCE SHEET SIGNED BY THE EMPLOYEE RECORDS THAT DOCUMENT THAT AN EMPLOYEE HAS BEEN TRAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH MOSH STANDARDS
- (I) DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN EMPLOYEE SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM DESIGNED TO INFORM EMPLOYEES OF AND TRAIN EMPLOYEES IN THE APPLICABLE STANDARDS FOR THE SAFE OPERATION OF POWER EQUIPMENT INCLUDING:
 - 1. LIMITATIONS AND USE;
 - 2. RATED LOAD CAPACITIES; AND
 - 3. SPECIAL HAZARDS; OR
- (II) ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDED MODEL TRAINING PROGRAM DEVELOPED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;
 - (2) MAINTAIN ON FILE FOR INSPECTION:
- (I) <u>A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE EMPLOYEE TRAINING</u> PROGRAM; AND
- (II) A NOTATION OF WHERE AN EMPLOYEE RECEIVED SAFETY TRAINING, IF THE EMPLOYER DID NOT PROVIDE THE EMPLOYEE WITH SAFETY TRAINING;
- (3) ASSURE THAT THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE MANUFACTURER APPLICABLE TO THE OPERATION OF A PIECE OF
