INTENTS AND PURPOSES, THE TRUE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN SAID COUNTIES.

10-12. PLACEMENT OF NUMBERED GRANITE POSTS MARKING SURVEY.

SAID COMMISSIONERS SHALL MARK THE SURVEY SO MADE BY THEM BY GRANITE POSTS EVERY HALF (1/2) MILE AND ALL STRAIGHT COURSES OF LESS LENGTH THAN ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE, WHICH SAID POSTS SHALL BE NUMBERED.

10-13. COMPENSATION.

SAID COMMISSIONERS SHALL EACH RECEIVE FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.) PER DAY FOR THE TIME ACTUALLY ENGAGED FOR THEIR SERVICES UNDER THIS ARTICLE. THE SURVEYOR SHALL RECEIVE THE SUM OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.) PER DAY, AND OTHER LABORERS SHALL RECEIVE THE SUM OF TWO DOLLARS (\$2.) PER DAY.

CHAPTER 13 BRIDGES

13-1. JOINT CONSTRUCTION OF BRIDGE AUTHORIZED; COSTS.

THERE SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED JOINTLY BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY AND THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY A CONCRETE BRIDGE FOR THE FREE TRAVEL OF THE PUBLIC OVER MATTAWOMAN CREEK ON THE ROAD LEADING FROM ACTON'S CROSSING IN CHARLES COUNTY TO ASBURY CHURCH IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY. THE COST OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID BRIDGE, INCLUDING THE ABUTMENTS AND APPROACHES THEREOF, AND THE SECURING OF ANY NECESSARY LAND SHALL BE BORNE EQUALLY BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY AND BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, AND SAID COMMISSIONERS OF EACH OF SAID COUNTIES ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO LEVY AGAINST THE ASSESSABLE PROPERTY OF THEIR SAID COUNTIES AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.) TO DEFRAY THEIR HALF OF THE EXPENSES OF BUILDING SAID BRIDGE.

13-2. ORGANIZATION OF JOINT COMMISSION: PURPOSE.

THE COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY AND THE COMMISSIONERS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY ARE HEREBY CONSTITUTED A JOINT COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SAID BRIDGE, AND THEY ARE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROCEED TO ORGANIZE AS SUCH COMMISSION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER APRIL 11, 1916, AND THEY ARE FURTHER AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A SAFE AND DURABLE CONCRETE BRIDGE OVER SAID MATTAWOMAN CREEK AT SAID POINT.
