

PERSON BY REASON OF RETIREMENT FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH THE COUNTY SHALL BE SUBTRACTED FROM ANY RETIREMENT SALARY PAYABLE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) THE ANNUAL RETIREMENT SALARY PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE PAID TO THE RECIPIENT ON A MONTHLY BASIS.

CHAPTER 30
CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

30-1. LEGAL REPRESENTATION.

A. A MEMBER OF A LAW FIRM MAY NOT REPRESENT ANY PERSON BEFORE ANY UNIT OF GOVERNMENT OF CHARLES COUNTY WHICH ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE SAME FIRM REPRESENTS.

B. A MEMBER OF A LAW FIRM MAY NOT REPRESENT ANY PERSON BEFORE ANY GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CHARLES COUNTY WHICH THAT MEMBER REPRESENTS.

CHAPTER 34
DREDGING OPERATIONS

34-1. CERTAIN DREDGING OPERATIONS PROHIBITED; PENALTY PROVISIONS.

A. UNLAWFUL DREDGING ACTIVITIES; EXCEPTION. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO DREDGE FOR SAND, GRAVEL OR OTHER AGGREGATES OR MINERALS IN ANY OF THE TIDAL WATERS OR MARSHLANDS OF CHARLES COUNTY, PROVIDED THAT THIS CHAPTER SHALL NOT CONFLICT WITH ANY NECESSARY CHANNEL DREDGING OPERATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF NAVIGATION.

B. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.) NOR MORE THAN TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.), PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT EACH DAY SUCH OFFENSE CONTINUES SHALL BE A SEPARATE VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER AND SUBJECT TO PENALTIES THEREOF.

CHAPTER 38
ELECTION DISTRICTS

38-1. NUMBER OF DISTRICTS DESIGNATED.

CHARLES COUNTY SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO NINE (9) ELECTION DISTRICTS ACCORDING TO THEIR PRESENT BOUNDS AND LIMITS, IN EACH OF WHICH DISTRICTS ELECTIONS SHALL BE HELD AT THE PLACE WHICH MAY BE ESTABLISHED THEREIN FOR THAT PURPOSE.
