

D. SPECIFY THE PROCEDURES FOR THE APPOINTMENT, TERMS AND REMOVAL OF BOARD MEMBERS.

E. SET PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE POWERS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY CREATED BY THIS SECTION.

41-2. APPLICABILITY OF LICENSING REQUIREMENTS; ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS.

A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF INSTALLING, ERECTING OR REPAIRING ELECTRICAL WIRES, CONDUCTORS AND OTHER ELECTRICAL APPARATUS OF LOW VOLTAGE MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED.

B. THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS AND SUPERVISORS OF ELECTRICIANS SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

41-3. APPLICABILITY OF PROVISIONS.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER MAY NOT APPLY TO:

A. ANY PERSON WHO EXERCISES A FRANCHISE GRANTED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION; OR

B. ANY OTHER PERSON WHO PERFORMS ELECTRICAL WORK FOR A PERSON WHO EXERCISES A FRANCHISE GRANTED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IF THE ELECTRICAL WORK IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE PLANT OR SERVICE USED BY THE PERSON IN RENDERING DULY AUTHORIZED SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC UNDER THE FRANCHISE.

CHAPTER 45  
FENCES

45-1. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF PARTITION FENCES; COSTS.

PARTITION FENCES BETWEEN THE ADJOINING FIELDS OF DIFFERENT PROPRIETORS IN CHARLES COUNTY SHALL BE MADE AND REPAIRED BY THE PARTIES RESPECTIVELY OWNING OR OCCUPYING THE FIELDS AT THEIR JOINT AND EQUAL EXPENSE. UPON FAILURE OF EITHER PARTY TO MAKE OR REPAIR HIS RESPECTIVE PROPORTION OF SUCH FENCE OR PAY HIS EQUAL SHARE OF THE COSTS THEREOF, HE SHALL BE ANSWERABLE THEREFOR IN AN ACTION OF DEBT, TO BE RECOVERED BEFORE A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE, BUT NO PERSON SHALL BE SO ANSWERABLE UNLESS THE FENCE, FOR THE MAKING OR REPAIR OF WHICH HE SHALL BE SUED, SHALL HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED OF THE USUAL MATERIALS AND IN THE ORDINARY WAY.
