1987, AND THEREAFTER FOR A FOUR-YEAR (4-YEAR) TERM.

- (B) FOR THE ONE (1) MEMBER WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE CHARLES COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS A TERM OF FOUR (4) YEARS, TO BE FILLED ON WHATEVER TIME BASIS THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SO CHOOSE, BUT ONLY WHILE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER IS SERVING A TERM OF OFFICE IN THAT CAPACITY.
- (C) FOR THE ONE (1) MEMBER WHO IS ELECTED BY THE CHARLES COUNTY VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION A ONE-YEAR (1-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 1988; THEREAFTER, THE MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A FOUR-YEAR 4-YEAR TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1989.
- (D) FOR THE ONE (1) MEMBER WHO IS ELECTED BY THE CHARLES COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES A TWO-YEAR (2-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 1988; THEREAFTER, THE MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A FOUR-YEAR (4-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1990.
- (E) FOR THE TWO (2) MEMBERS WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ONE (1) FOR A TWO-YEAR (2-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1988; THEREAFTER, THAT MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A FOUR-YEAR (4-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1990. THE OTHER MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED TO A THREE-YEAR (3-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1988; THEREAFTER, THAT MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A FOUR-YEAR (4-YEAR) TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1991.
- THE BOARD OF FIRE AND RESCUE COMMISSIONERS SHALL REVIEW THE FINANCING OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND RESCUE SQUADS INCLUDING MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE UNITS IN CHARLES COUNTY AND MAKE APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATIONS WITH RESPECT THERETO. DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS, CONSTITUTING THE PROCEEDS OF THE FIRE AND RESCUE TAX, SHALL BE TO THE VARIOUS FIRE DEPARTMENTS, RESCUE SOUADS, AND MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE UNITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A FORMULA AGREED UPON BY THE BOARD OF FIRE AND RESCUE COMMISSIONERS AND THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CHARLES COUNTY VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION AND THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CHARLES COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, PROVIDING, HOWEVER, THAT IF SUCH AGREEMENT CANNOT BE REACHED THE FORMULA EMPLOYED IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S DISTRIBUTION SHALL CONTINUE IN USE UNTIL SUCH AGREEMENT IS REACHED. THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE FIRE AND RESCUE TAX SHALL BE ALLOCATED AND DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) REVENUE DERIVED FROM TEN CENTS (\$0.10) OF THE FIRE AND RESCUE TAX SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE VARIOUS FIRE
