COMMISSIONERS SHALL FIND IT NECESSARY TO OBTAIN GRAVEL OR OTHER MATERIAL LYING ALONG OR WITHIN THREE (3) MILES OF THE LINE OF ANY ROAD OF CHARLES COUNTY FOR THE USE OF GRADING AND REPAIRING, IT MAY MAKE SUCH AGREEMENT AS IT MAY SEE FIT WITH THE OWNER OR OWNERS THEREOF FOR SECURING THE SAME, AND IF NO AGREEMENT CAN BE MADE, SAID BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY SHALL PROCEED IN LIKE MANNER AS ABOVE SET FORTH FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF LAND FOR AN OUTLET OR WATERCOURSE.

104-4. ANNUAL LEVY FOR CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY SHALL, AT THE TIME OF MARKING THE ANNUAL LEVY IN SAID COUNTY FOR THE YEAR 1931, LEVY IN SAID YEAR, UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY OF SAID COUNTY, THE SUM OF SEVENTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$17,000.) AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER LEVY, UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY OF SAID COUNTY, THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE ROADS AND BRIDGES OF SAID COUNTY, SAID SUMS TO BE HELD BY THE TREASURER OF CHARLES COUNTY, SUBJECT TO THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS OF SAID CHARLES COUNTY, TO BE BY THEM EXPENDED IN THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PUBLIC ROADS AND BRIDGES OF SAID CHARLES COUNTY.

104-5. DAMAGE OR OBSTRUCTION GENERALLY; PENALTY PROVISIONS.

IF A PERSON SHALL OBSTRUCT, FILL UP OR OTHERWISE WILLFULLY INJURE THE DRAINS MADE FOR CONDUCTING THE WATER FROM THE PUBLIC ROADS OR SHALL ENCROACH UPON ANY PUBLIC ROADS BY FENCES OR OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS OR DIG ANY DITCH OR DRAIN ACROSS ANY ROAD AND FAIL TO KEEP SUCH DITCH OR DRAIN WELL COVERED AND IN GOOD REPAIR FOR THE PASSAGE OF VEHICLES OVER THE SAME OR IF ANY PERSON SHALL DRAIN ANY WATER INTO OR UPON ANY PUBLIC ROAD, EACH AND EVERY SUCH PERSON, FOR EVERY SUCH OFFENSE, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE FOR THE USE OF THE COUNTY OF NOT LESS THAN TEN DOLLARS (\$10.) NOR MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.).

104-6. ERECTION OR MAINTENANCE OF GATES PROHIBITED; RESPONSIBILITIES OF ROAD SUPERVISORS.

A. REMOVAL OF GATES AUTHORIZED. IT SHALL NOT BE LAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, WITH OR WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TO ERECT, HAVE OR KEEP ANY GATE UPON THE PUBLIC ROADS OF CHARLES COUNTY, AND THE ROAD SUPERVISORS OF SAID COUNTY SHALL CAUSE ALL GATES TO BE REMOVED THEREFROM IN THEIR RESPECTIVE DISTRICTS.
