- F. DISCIPLINARY ACTION; APPEAL.
- (1) THE SHERIFF MAY, IN HIS DISCRETION, SUSPEND WITHOUT PAY, REMOVE, DISMISS, DEMOTE OR DISCHARGE ANY MEMBER OF HIS OFFICE FOR ANY OFFENSE AGAINST LAW OR GOOD MORALS, FOR NEGLECT OF DUTY, INEFFICIENCY, PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITY OR BREACH OF DISCIPLINE.
- (2) THE FOLLOWING OFFENSES SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUFFICIENT TO WARRANT SUSPENSION, DISCHARGE OR DEMOTION:
  - (A) COWARDICE.
  - (B) WILLFUL DISOBEDIENCE OF RULES OR ORDERS.
- (C) ANY ACT OF CRUELTY, TYRANNY OR OPPRESSION TOWARD A CIVILIAN OR ANY OTHER OFFICER.
  - (D) CONDUCT UNBECOMING AN OFFICER.
  - (E) IMMORAL OR INDECENT BEHAVIOR.
- (F) DRINKING INTOXICATING LIQUORS OR BEVERAGES WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY, EITHER IN UNIFORM OR PLAIN CLOTHES.
- (G) VISITING ANY GAMBLING HOUSE OR HOUSE OF ILL FAME NOT IN THE COURSE OF HIS DUTY.
  - (H) ABSENCE WITHOUT LEAVE.
  - (I) SLEEPING ON DUTY.
  - (J) ABSENCE FROM DUTY WITHOUT PROPER EXCUSE.
  - (K) IGNORANCE OF RULES OR ORDERS.
- (L) NEGLECT TO PAY ANY JUST DEBT CONTRACTED AFTER APPOINTMENT.
- (M) DISCLOSING ANY PROPOSED ACTION OR MOVEMENT IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- (N) ASKING OR ACCEPTING A BRIBE FOR PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.
  - (O) UNNECESSARY USE OF REVOLVER OR CLUB.
- (P) ANY OTHER WILLFUL OR FLAGRANT VIOLATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE.
- (Q) ANY CONDUCT PREJUDICIAL TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF.
  - (3) ANY MEMBER SO SUSPENDED OR REMOVED MAY APPEAL
