LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (1) IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF EVERY LICENSEE TO KEEP A REGISTER CONTAINING A RECORD OF ALL TRAILER COACH OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS LOCATED WITHIN A PARK. THE REGISTER SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - (A) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH OCCUPANT.
- (B) THE MAKE, MODEL AND YEAR OF ALL AUTOMOBILES AND TRAILER COACHES.
- (C) THE LICENSE NUMBER AND OWNER OF EACH TRAILER COACH AND AUTOMOBILE BY WHICH IT IS TOWED.
 - (D) THE STATE ISSUING SUCH LICENSE.
- (E) THE DATE OF ARRIVAL AND OF DEPARTURE OF EACH TRAILER COACH.
- (2) THE LICENSE SHALL KEEP THE REGISTER AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION AT ALL TIMES BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIALS AND OTHER OFFICIALS WHOSE DUTIES NECESSITATE ACQUISITION OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE REGISTER. THE REGISTER RECORDS SHALL NOT BE DESTROYED FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS FOLLOWING THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.
- H. REVOCATION OF LICENSE; REISSUANCE. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REVOKE ANY LICENSE TO MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A PARK WHEN THE LICENSEE HAS BEEN FOUND GUILTY BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION OF VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER. AFTER SUCH CONVICTION, THE LICENSE MAY BE REISSUED IF THE CIRCUMSTANCES LEADING TO CONVICTION HAVE BEEN REMEDIED AND THE PARK IS OPERATED AND MAINTAINED IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW.
- I. CONSPICUOUS POSTING OF LICENSE REQUIRED. THE LICENSE CERTIFICATE SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED IN THE OFFICE OF OR ON THE PREMISES OF THE TRAILER COACH PARK AT ALL TIMES.
- J. SEVERABILITY. SHOULD ANY SECTION OR PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER BE DECLARED INVALID, SUCH DECISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINING PORTIONS OF THIS CHAPTER.
- K. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE FINED NOT LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.) NOR MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.) FOR EACH OFFENSE. EACH DAY THAT A VIOLATION IS PERMITTED TO EXIST SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
