(3) The annual amount of a scholarship may not exceed the equivalent annual tuition and mandatory fees of the undergraduate in-state student at the University of Maryland College Park.

CHAPTER 495

(Senate Bill 667)

AN ACT concerning

Real Estate Brokers - Disclosure of Relationship with Seller

FOR the purpose of specifying that the circumstances when a licensed real estate broker, licensed associate real estate broker, or licensed real estate salesperson participating in a residential real estate transaction as a selling or cooperating licensee must make a certain written disclosure of representation of the seller or lessor to a prospective buyer or lessee; requiring that a licensed real estate broker, licensed associate real estate broker, or licensed real estate salesperson disclose to a seller, lessor, or licensee representing the seller or lessor an agreement to represent a prospective buyer or lessee before the occurrence of the first of certain events; defining certain terms; and generally relating to disclosure of a relationship with a seller or lessor to a buyer or lessee.
