AGREEMENT TO THE SELLER, LESSOR, OR LICENSEE REPRESENTING THE SELLER OR LESSOR BEFORE THE FIRST OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS OCCURS:

- (I) THE SHOWING OF THE PROPERTY; OR
- (II) THE PRESENTATION OF AN INITIAL OFFER TO PURCHASE OR LEASE.
- [(d)] (E) The Commission may adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this section.
