(b) “Law enforcement officer” means any person who, in his official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is a member of one of the following law enforcement agencies:

(3) THE BALTIMORE CITY SCHOOL POLICE FORCE;

Article 4 – Baltimore City

16-16. Special police officers.

The Police Commissioner of Baltimore City is hereby authorized, in the exercise of his discretion, upon the application of any corporation, association, firm or person in the City of Baltimore that the said Commissioner may deem responsible, to appoint suitable persons as special police officers to serve without pay from the said City or the State of Maryland, and the corporation, association, firm or person applying for such appointment shall be liable for the official misconduct, wrongful or negligent acts of the officer appointed on such application. Every special police officer appointed under the provisions of this section shall, upon the premises of the corporation, association, firm or person for which he may have
