

neglect of a duty required by law, unprofessional conduct, or dishonorable conduct.

(9) The removal procedure is as provided in this article.

(c) (1) A majority of the members then serving on the board is a quorum.

(2) The board shall meet at least once a month.

(3) The chairperson of the board shall receive an annual compensation of \$10,000 and be reimbursed for reasonable expenses.

(4) The members shall receive an annual compensation of \$5,000 and be reimbursed for reasonable expenses.

Chapter 79 of the Acts of 1989

[SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the chairperson and members of the board of license commissioners in Frederick County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the chairperson and members of the board of license commissioners in Frederick County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1990.
