THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT:

~~(1) LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY PERSON TO PRACTICE A HEALTH OCCUPATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE;~~

~~(2) LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY GROUP OF PERSONS LICENSED UNDER THE SAME TITLE OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE FROM PRACTICING AS A BUSINESS UNDER THIS TITLE;~~

~~(3) (1) LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO ACT AS AUTHORIZED BY THAT LICENSE; OR~~

~~(4) (2) PROHIBIT THE CARE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RELIES ON TREATMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TENETS AND PRACTICES OF A RECOGNIZED CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS DENOMINATION AND, WITH OR WITHOUT COMPENSATION, IS PROVIDED CARE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THOSE TENETS AND PRACTICES.~~

(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS FOR THE CARE, TREATMENT, HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE, AND COMFORT OF INDIVIDUALS WHO RECEIVE HOME HEALTH CARE SERVICES THROUGH A RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCY.

(B) THE REGULATIONS SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCIES AND THE ANNUAL RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

(C) THE REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE THE SECRETARY TO CHARGE FEES IN A MANNER WHICH WILL PRODUCE FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO AT LEAST COVER THE ACTUAL DIRECT OR INDIRECT COSTS OF THE INSPECTION AND LICENSURE OF RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

~~(C) (D) THE REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE PROVISIONS THAT:~~

~~(1) PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCIES;~~

~~(2) ESTABLISH QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE;~~

~~(3) SET MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO PROVIDE HOME HEALTH CARE SERVICES THROUGH A RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCY; AND~~
