SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

167.

- (a) The attorney for the County Commissioners for Kent County shall also be the attorney for the liquor control board for Kent County and shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) per annum in addition to the salary that he receives as attorney for the County Commissioners for Kent County.
- (b) The department of liquor control for Montgomery County shall [be immune from all suits for damages and shall be subject to suit only for the enforcement of contracts made by it] HAVE THE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY DESCRIBED UNDER TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 3 § 5-318 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE.
