[(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and except as otherwise expressly provided in this section, the Fund retains and may raise the defense of sovereign immunity in any action.

(b) Obligations arising out of a written contract executed by the Fund on or after May 18, 1985 may be enforced in accordance with Title 12, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article.] THE FUND SHALL HAVE THE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY DESCRIBED UNDER ~~TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 3~~ § 5-365 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE.

(a) The Department and the State [are not liable to any lender for payment of the principal or interest on a loan to an eligible business] SHALL HAVE THE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY DESCRIBED UNDER ~~TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 3~~ § 5-366 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE.
