- (11) The State share of basic current expenses as provided in § 5-202 of this subtitle:
 - (12) Student transportation[;] as provided in § 5-203 of this subtitle; [and]
- (13) The school building construction aid as provided in $\S 5-301(c)$ of this title; AND
- (14) THE EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER PURCHASE MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM AS PROVIDED IN § 7–106.1 OF THIS ARTICLE. 7–106.1.
- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "COMPUTER SUPPLIER" MEANS A MERCHANT WHO DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY OFFERS OR MAKES AVAILABLE TO CONSUMERS ANY EDUCATIONAL COMPUTERS.
- (3) "EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER" MEANS THE COMPUTER AND NECESSARY COMPONENTS THAT ENABLE A STUDENT TO PERFORM EDUCATIONAL TASKS UNDER SUPERVISION BY AN INSTRUCTOR.
- (4) "ELIGIBLE SCHOOL" MEANS ANY PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED WITHIN A COUNTY DETERMINED TO BE ELIGIBLE UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- (5) "FUND" MEANS THE EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER PURCHASE MATCHING FUND.
- (6) "PARENT TEACHER UNIT" MEANS A PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION, PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION, OR ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS FORMED AT A SCHOOL AND RECOGNIZED BY THE MAJORITY OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS AT THAT SCHOOL AS REPRESENTING THE INTERESTS OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS AT THAT SCHOOL.
- (7) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER PURCHASE MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM.
- (B) (1) THERE IS AN EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER PURCHASE MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
 - (2) THE FUND IS ESTABLISHED TO:
- (I) PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF COMPUTERS IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS WITH INSUFFICIENT FUNDS TO PURCHASE SUCH COMPUTERS; AND
 - (II) ENCOURAGE PARENT TEACHER UNITS AT ELIGIBLE
