SCHOOLS TO RAISE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EDUCATIONAL COMPUTERS FOR THEIR SCHOOLS.

- (3) THROUGH THE FUND, THE STATE SHALL SHARE IN 20 PERCENT OF THE COST OF PURCHASING COMPUTERS FOR ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS.
- (C) (1) (I) IN THIS SUBSECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (II) "FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT ENROLLMENT" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 5-202 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (III) "PER PUPIL WEALTH" MEANS THE WEALTH OF A COUNTY DIVIDED BY THE FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT ENROLLMENT OF A COUNTY.
- (IV) "STATEWIDE AVERAGE PER PUPIL WEALTH" MEANS THE SUM OF THE WEALTH OF ALL THE COUNTIES IN THE STATE DIVIDED BY THE FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT ENROLLMENT OF A COUNTY.
- (V) "WEALTH" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 5–202 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (2) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:
- (I) DETERMINE WHICH COUNTIES ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM; AND
- (II) NOTIFY EACH COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.
- (3) A COUNTY IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM IF THE COUNTY PER PUPIL WEALTH IS LESS THAN 65 PERCENT OF THE STATEWIDE AVERAGE FOR PER PUPIL WEALTH.
- (4) UPON NOTIFICATION OF COUNTY ELIGIBILITY BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:
- (I) INFORM THE PRINCIPALS OF ALL ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY OF THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE COUNTY AND THE APPLICATION PROCESS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM; AND
- (II) REQUIRE THE PRINCIPALS OF ALL ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS TO INFORM THE PARENT TEACHER UNIT AT THE ELIGIBLE SCHOOL OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM.
