- [(r)] (S) The general administration, funding, and responsibility for the proper operation of this pension system is vested in the Board of Trustees for Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems. The proper operation of this pension system shall be as that provided for the operation of the Pension System for the Employees of the State of Maryland.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
