- (I) 2 ± 2 SHALL BE CERTIFIED GENERAL REAL ESTATE APPRAISERS;
- (II) 2 <u>1</u> SHALL BE <u>A</u> CERTIFIED RESIDENTIAL <u>REAL ESTATE</u> APPRAISER;
- (III) $\stackrel{?}{2}$ $\stackrel{1}{1}$ SHALL BE $\stackrel{A}{\underline{A}}$ LICENSED REAL ESTATE APPRAISERS APPRAISER;
- (IV) <u>3</u> <u>2</u> SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF A <u>FEDERAL</u> FINANCIAL INSTITUTION <u>WHO ARE NOT CERTIFIED OR LICENSED REAL ESTATE APPRAISERS</u>; AND
 - (V) 3 SHALL BE CONSUMER MEMBERS.
- (3) OF THE 6-REAL ESTATE APPRAISER 9 MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION:
- (I) 1 4 SHALL BE AN AT LARGE AT LARGE MEMBER MEMBERS;
- (II) 1 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF ANY COUNTY IN THE AREA THAT CONSISTS OF CAROLINE, CECIL, DORCHESTER, KENT, QUEEN ANNE'S, SOMERSET, TALBOT, WICOMICO, AND WORCESTER COUNTIES;
- (III) 1 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF ANY COUNTY IN THE AREA THAT CONSISTS OF BALTIMORE, CARROLL, HARFORD, AND HOWARD COUNTIES;
 - (IV) 1 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF BALTIMORE CITY;
- (V) 1 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF ANY COUNTY IN THE AREA THAT CONSISTS OF ANNE ARUNDEL, CALVERT, CHARLES, PRINCE GEORGE'S, AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES; AND
- (VI) 1 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF ANY COUNTY IN THE AREA THAT CONSISTS OF ALLEGANY, FREDERICK, GARRETT, MONTGOMERY, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES.
- (4) (I) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY AND WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (II) THE GOVERNOR MAY NOT APPOINT MORE THAN 2 MEMBERS FROM ANY 1 REGION SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (B) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE A CITIZEN OF THE STATE.
 - (C) EACH REAL ESTATE APPRAISER MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:
 - (1) SHALL HAVE BEEN A RESIDENT OF ANY OF THE COUNTIES
