- (A) (1) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.
- (2) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE CHAIRMAN MAY BE REELECTED.
- (B) THE CHAIRMAN SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES THAT THIS TITLE AND THE COMMISSION REQUIRE.
- (C) WHILE IN OFFICE, THE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE COVERED BY A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY LAW.
- (A) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 7 $\underline{5}$ \underline{OF} \underline{THE} MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ARE A QUORUM.
- (2) AT LEAST 4- 2 OF THE 7- 5 MEMBERS SHALL BE REAL ESTATE APPRAISER MEMBERS.
- (B) (1) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH CALENDAR QUARTER, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.
- (2) <u>EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL RECEIVE</u>
 WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF A MEETING AT LEAST 10
 DAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED DATE OF THE MEETING.
- (3) <u>WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER GIVING NOTICE TO THE COMMISSION</u>, <u>A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC IS ENTITLED TO BE HEARD</u>, <u>AT A MEETING OF THE COMMISSION</u>, <u>ON ANY MATTER WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION</u>.
- (2) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL RECEIVE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF A MEETING AT LEAST 10 DAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED DATE OF THE MEETING.
- (3) WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER GIVING NOTICE TO THE COMMISSION, A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC IS ENTITLED TO BE HEARD, AT A MEETING OF THE COMMISSION, ON ANY MATTER WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION.
 - (C) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS ENTITLED TO:
- (1) COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET; AND
- (2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
