

(B) ON REQUEST, THE COMMISSION SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC A COPY OF THE ROSTER AT A REASONABLE PRICE THAT THE COMMISSION SETS.

ON REQUEST, THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A DOCUMENT OF GOOD STANDING TO A LICENSED REAL ESTATE APPRAISER OR CERTIFIED REAL ESTATE APPRAISER WHO:

- (1) IS IN GOOD STANDING IN THE STATE; AND
- (2) PAYS THE ISSUANCE FEE SET BY THE COMMISSION.

THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY AN ANNUAL REPORT THAT INCLUDES:

- (1) A STATEMENT OF THE TOTAL RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES OF THE COMMISSION; AND
- (2) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT REFLECTS THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION.

15.5-216.

IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSION MAY:

- (1) SPONSOR RESEARCH AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES ABOUT REAL ESTATE APPRAISING; AND
- (2) ADOPT ANY REGULATION TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

15.5-217.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, THE COMMISSION SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSION IN A CONTESTED CASE, AS DEFINED IN § 10-201 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, MAY TAKE AN APPEAL AS ALLOWED IN §§ 10-215 AND 10-216 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

THE COMMISSION EXERCISES ITS POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY.
