- (A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO PROVIDE REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL SERVICES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
- (B) THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE ONLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- (1) SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSION AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSION PROVIDES:
- (2) SUBMITS EVIDENCE THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO APPRAISE REAL ESTATE AND REAL PROPERTY IN THE STATE OF DOMICILE OF THE INDIVIDUAL;
- (3) SUBMITS A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE CONTRACT FOR REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL SERVICES THAT REQUIRES THE INDIVIDUAL TO APPRAISE REAL ESTATE IN THIS STATE:
- (4) CERTIFIES THAT DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS ARE NOT PENDING AGAINST THE INDIVIDUAL IN THE STATE OF DOMICILE OF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- (5) PAYS TO THE COMMISSION AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$25; AND
- (6) COMPLIES WITH ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT SET BY THE COMMISSION.
- (C) WHILE A TEMPORARY LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PROVIDE ONLY THE REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL SERVICES THAT ARE REQUIRED BY THE CONTRACT FOR APPRAISAL SERVICES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL SUBMITS WITH THE APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY LICENSE.
 - (D) A TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES:
- (1) NOT LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE DATE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE IS ISSUED; OR
- (2) IF IT OCCURS SOONER, THE DATE THE APPRAISAL WORK REQUIRED BY THE CONTRACT FOR APPRAISAL SERVICES IS COMPLETED.
- (E) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT ISSUE MORE THAN 3 TEMPORARY LICENSES TO THE SAME INDIVIDUAL IN A 3 YEAR PERIOD.
 - (A) THE COMMISSION SHALL:
 - (1) TRANSMIT TO THE APPRAISAL SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE
