- (18) State Board of Social Work Examiners (§ 18-201 of the Health Occupations Article);
- (19) State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathologists (§ 19-201 of the Health Occupations Article);

- (21) State Board of Examiners of Professional Counselors (§ 15.5-201 of the Health Occupations Article); [and]
- (22) Governor's Council on Adolescent Pregnancy (§ 15-201 of the Family Law Article); AND
- (23) STATE COMMISSION OF REAL ESTATE APPRAISERS (§ 15.5–201 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE).
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall appoint:
- (1) The initial 6 real estate appraiser members of the Commission, with 2 members serving 1 year terms, 2 members serving 2 year terms, and 2 members serving 3 year terms; and
- (2) The initial 3 consumer members and the initial 3 federal financial institution members serving terms of 1, 2, and 3 years, respectively.
- (1) The initial 4 real estate appraiser members of the Commission, with 2 members serving a 1-year term, 1 member serving a 2-year term, and 1 member serving a 3-year term; and
- (2) The initial 3 consumer members and the initial 2 federal financial institution members, with 1 member of each group serving a 1-year term, 1 member from each group serving a 2-year term, and 1 consumer member serving a 3-year term.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each real estate appraiser who is appointed to the Commission before the Commission begins to license and certify real estate appraisers and who possess the qualifications otherwise required by this title shall be considered to be licensed and certified for purposes of appointment as a member of the Commission.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Commission shall grant a waiver of the examination and classroom study requirements for licensing to any individual who:
 - (1) Is employed on January 1, 1991 as a real estate appraiser;
- (2) Has obtained at least 5 years of real estate appraisal experience within the 7 years immediately before the date of application;
 - (3) Submits an application to the Commission on the form the Commission
