- (2) ONE STUDENT MEMBER.
- (B) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL:
- (1) BE AN ELEVENTH OR TWELFTH GRADE STUDENT IN THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM;
  - (2) SERVE FOR 1 YEAR;
  - (3) BE A NONVOTING MEMBER; AND
- (4) ADVISE THE BOARD ON THE THOUGHTS AND FEELINGS OF STUDENTS.
- (C) UNLESS INVITED TO ATTEND BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF THE COUNTY BOARD, THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT ATTEND AN EXECUTIVE SESSION THAT RELATES TO:
- (1) HEARINGS ON APPEALS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION PLACEMENTS;
  - (2) HEARINGS HELD UNDER § 6-202(A) OF THIS ARTICLE; OR
  - (3) COLLECTIVE BARGAINING OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 607

(House Bill 830)

## Public Service Commission - Recorded Solicitations - Penalties

FOR the purpose of elarifying that the use of an automated telephone address signaling system for certain purposes is prohibited unless there is a certain business relationship with, or consent from, the person called; providing a penalty for a violation of a prohibition on the use of automated telephone address signaling systems for certain purposes; requiring senders of certain automated dialing, push-button, or tone-activated address signaling calls to disconnect certain prerecorded message machines at within a certain time; providing a certain exception exceptions; and generally relating to the use of certain automated telephone address signaling systems.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 78 – Public Service Commission Law Section 55C
