- (II) A DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT:
- (III) AN ACCURATE ESTIMATE OF THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF THE PRO RATA CHARGE THAT MAY BE LEVIED AGAINST EACH PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT: AND
- (IV) A DESCRIPTION OF THE ROADS TO BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THE DISTRICT.
- (5) NOTICE OF THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE OF THE HEARING SHALL BE PUBLISHED AT LEAST TWICE IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY NOT MORE THAN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE HEARING.
- (I) (H) (1) BEFORE AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ROAD DISTRICT UNDER THIS SECTION BECOMES EFFECTIVE IT SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO A REFERENDUM OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND RESIDENTS OF THE DISTRICT OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT.
- (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THE REFERENDUM, VOTES SHALL BE COUNTED ON A 1 VOTE PER LIVING UNIT DENSITY BASIS.
- (3) (2) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ADOPTION OF THE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ROAD DISTRICT, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL SPECIFY:
- (I) THE DAY, PLACE, AND THE HOURS FOR THE REFERENDUM; AND
- (II) AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE LAKE LINGANORE ASSOCIATION, INC., THE PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA THAT WILL BE USED TO COUNT THE VOTES ON A 1 VOTE PER LIVING UNIT DENSITY BASIS.
- (4) (3) NOT LESS THAN 15 DAYS AND NOT MORE THAN 45 DAYS BEFORE THE REFERENDUM, NOTICE OF THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE OF THE REFERENDUM SHALL BE PUBLISHED TWICE AT NOT LESS THAN WEEKLY INTERVALS IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY.
- (5) THE PLACE FOR THE REFERENDUM SHALL BE WITHIN THE DISTRICT ESTABLISHED IN THE ORDINANCE.
- (6) (4) ON THE DATE AND AT THE TIME AND PLACE SPECIFIED, THE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ROAD DISTRICT WITHIN THE LAKE LINGANORE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO A REFERENDUM OF THE PERSONS WHO RESIDE OR OWN PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT.
 - (7) (5) THE BALLOTS SHALL CONTAIN A SUMMARY OF THE
