~~(3)~~ (4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE OR THE LAWS OF ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, ON VERIFICATION OF THE SERVICE CREDIT, THE RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM FROM WHICH THE TRANSFER IS MADE MAY NOT PROVIDE ANY BENEFIT FOR THE SERVICE TRANSFERRED.

CHAPTER 610

(House Bill 851)

AN ACT concerning

**Creation of a State Debt – Charles County Visual and Special Arts Center**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$100,000~~ \$50,000 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Commissioners of Charles County for the planning of the Charles County Visual and Special Arts Center at Chapel Point State Park, subject to the requirement that the County Commissioners of Charles County provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Charles County
